

Guideline: Airspace

1. PROHIBITED AREA, RESTRICTED AREA, DANGER AREA

means the airspace declared for an area because area is important or may affect the safety of flight operations Aircraft are generally prohibited from flying. Unless specifically authorized. Which can be divided into 3 main types as follows

- 1.1 Prohibited Area: An airspace of defined dimensions, above the land areas or territorial waters of a State, within which the flight of aircraft is prohibited. Most of the areas are under the military. or is an area where need for national security the height from the ground to the height is not limited. In such areas, aircraft are not allowed to fly over 24 hours a day.
- 1.2 Restricted Area: An airspace of defined dimensions, above the land areas or territorial waters of a State, within which the flight of aircraft is restricted in accordance with certain specified conditions. For example the residence area of the royal family or palace, In the area of Bangkok an area with a radius of 19 kilometers from the Victory Monument has been announced. And set the height range from 0 to 3,000 feet as a specific restricted area. Which is called VT R1 Bangkok City, which is a prohibited area. Because it is a community area There are tall buildings and high population density. In which the flight of the actual aircraft can only be flown in the case of a necessary mission. And will have to ask for permission from the Civil Aviation Authority of Thailand for unmaned aircraft or drones and have to flying in accordance with the conditions specified by Thailaw
- 1.3 Danger Area: An airspace of defined dimensions within which activities dangerous to the flight of aircraft may exist at specified time. The effect of the creation of danger area is to caution operators or pilots of aircraft that it is necessary for them to assess the dangers in relation to their responsibility for the safety of their aircraft. For example, it is a Military exercise area or a flight training area. Therefore, the airspace will be defined as a dangerous area (Danger area) when there is an activity that may cause

danger to aircraft. It is considered that the pilot in command of the aircraft can avoid the danger by himself. and must be very careful in-flight operations during the specified period

2. Important Information about PROHIBITED AREA, RESTRICTED AREA, DANGER AREA

The vertical and lateral dimensions of prohibited areas are published in national Aeronautical Information Publications (AIPs) together with the hours of operation where applicable. You can see more information via https://aip.caat.or.th/

3.1 RESTRICTED AREAS: VT R1 Bangkok City




Type of restriction: heavy traffic


Area radius: 10 nautical miles (18.52 kilometers)

Time of activity: all time

Height: Ground to a height of 3,000 feet or about 914 meters approximately



3.2 RESTRICTED AREAS: VT R3 Hua Hin Palace



Type of restriction: Royal Residence Area


Area radius: 1 nautical mile (1.852 kilometers)

Time of activity: Notified NOTAM (Notice to Air Men)

Height: Ground to a height of 6,000 feet or about 1,828 meters approximately



3.3 DENGER AREAS: VT D41 MAE RIM, CHIANG MAI



VT D41 Mae Rim, Chiang Mai
Area bounded by lines joining successively
the following points: 202700N995400E on
Thai-Myanmar border to 184700N 995400E
184700N 990900E then follow the arc 10
NM counter clockwise from Chiang Mai
TACAN (184612N985812E) to
185600N985400E 191800N984200E
194600N984200E on Thai-Myanmar border
thence follow the boundary to the starting
point. Excluding Airway W20 between
altitude 7500 ft to FL200, Chiang mai TMA
and Chinag rai TMA

Nature of hazard, activity : High speed combat maneuvering

Time of activity : Mon - Fri, 0100-1400

Inflight information : FOCAL Control freq. 127.0 MHZ or 331.3 MHZ If unable contact Chiang Mai Approach freq. 129.6 MHZ or 305.4 MHZ

Pilots are advised to contact prior to entering.



3.4 Prohibited AREAS: VT P38 Ko Chang - Ko Khud




Type of restriction: Royal Thai Navy Area (RTN Area)

Time of activity: Sunset to Sunrise


Height: Ground to a 5,000 Feet

The areas mentioned above are only part of the PROHIBITED, RESTRICTED, DANGER AREAS. in order to ensure that the flight operations are safe. You can check the prohibited areas by yourself by 2 methods as follows:

1. Download 2 files of prohibited areas (airports and no-fly areas) at the website. https://uav.caat.or.th/vtr1_detail2.php After that, put both files into the Google Earth Pro**, you will be able to easily bring the coordinates or places that you want to fly in the program.



- 2. Go to check the information in https://aip.caat.or.th/
 - A. Click on Currently Effective Issue.
 - B. Once entered, go to PART 2 EN-ROUTE (ENR) section ENR 5.1 PROHIBITED, RESTRICTED, DANGER AREAS.
 - C. After entering, you can immediately check which area you want to fly into.

If the area is a restricted area and dangerous areas, you must contact the agency that responsible for that area to request permission to fly, then send the documents to request permission to fly from CAAT
